- (iii) When any above named person ceases employment with the licence holder or transfers to other responsibilities, the licence holder must, as soon as practicably, notify the Department of Health and Human Services about the change, by completing the change or review form, available from the Victorian Medicines and Poisons Regulation website.

- (e) The holder of this licence must maintain true and accurate records showing full details of transactions involving all poisons or controlled substances obtained, used in sale, supply or disposal. These records must be retained for a period of three years and produced, in writing, on demand to an authorised officer of the Department of Health and Human Services.
- (f) The holder of this licence must notify the Department of Health Human Services of any requests for supply of poisons in quantities which appear to be inconsistent with the activities of the business for which it is being supplied.
- (g) The holder of this licence must ensure that any loss, theft or misappropriation of poisons is reported to Victoria Police, and to the Department of Health and Human Services.
- (h) The holder of this licence must store all products covered by this licence under conditions that will maintain their stability and quality. In the event of circumstances arising which may compromise the quality of the products, the licence holder must not supply them for use unless satisfactory quality has been confirmed.

- (g) The holder of this licence must notify the Department of Health forthwith of any requests for supply of Schedule 8 poisons in quantities which appear to be inconsistent with the activities of the business for which it is being supplied.
- (h) The holder of this licence must ensure that any loss, theft or misappropriation of Schedule 8 poisons is reported forthwith to the police, and in writing to the Department of Health.
- (i) The holder of this licence must ensure that the wholesaling operations are conducted in accordance with the current Australian Code of Good Wholesaling Practice for Medicines in Schedules 2, 3, 4 and 8.
